

TS07C Meeting of Presidents of African Land Professional Associations

Key decisions/recommendations

- Reviewed the HLFM held in Nov 2023 and urged for the full implementation of the decisions
- Opened discussion with the LOC for FIG 2025 WW on facilitating the African delegates' participation
- Urged for more integration of African land professionals and reduction of barriers



TS02C: The Quest for Good Land Governance in Africa; Connecting the Modern and Traditional Land Administration Systems to Bridge the Chasms

Key decisions/recommendations

- Support the review of national land laws to strengthen customary land titles issued under the authority of the traditional leaders
- Research, documentation, and protection of rights of women, ethnic minorities, and non-indigenes
- Land professionals to leverage technology and support the fit-for-purpose land administration
- Community Capacity Development is required to translate Africa's natural resources to wealth.



TS09C: Regional Capacity Development Networks-Collaboration Forum 1&2

Key decisions/recommendations

- Discussed CCD in Africa and identified weak legal, policy, spatial, and institutional arrangements as some of the key challenges
- Recommended more involvement of private partners in CCD
- Support to African states in strengthening land governance and institutional reforms
- Leverage the WB projects in Africa and promote access to educational and training support provided by international organizations



TS12C: The African Woman Land Professional and Good Land Governance in Africa

Key decisions/recommendations

- Discussed African women land professionals in land governance and identified tokenism, poor coordination, traditional practices, and perception as key challenges
- Noted tremendous improvement in number, visibility and impact of women land professionals in land governance in Africa in the last 20 years
- Recommended more women land professionals involvement in the African Union Land Governance Strategy 2023-2032
- Resolved to convene African women land professionals conference in November 2024
